- A mask/face covering may be worn at Parent's and Staff's discretion
- Social Distancing is practiced in all dance rooms and common areas
- Class times are staggered to allow for social distancing and cleaning
- Students must come to class fully dressed in appropriate dance attire
- Students must have dance shoes or socks – no bare feet
- No food/eating allowed in the studio at any time
- Hand sanitizing stations provided throughout the studio
- Students must sanitize or wash hands upon entering the studio
- Students must wash hands after toileting
- Supervised Drop-off and pick-up
- No sharing of materials/clothes/water bottles
- Any student having traveled out of state must take virtual classes for 14 days before returning
- All clothing/items must be labeled as there is no lost and found available
- Any student with COVID-like symptoms will be dismissed immediately
